This is to notify you that your Bid dated **31 December 2020** for execution of the Supply of Package Name: Patrol Boats (Surveillance) for MFSC, Package Number: GD 7-I for the Accepted Contract Amount of USD 1821798.00 (One Million Eight Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars), as corrected and modified in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders is hereby accepted by our Agency.

Following the ITB Clause No. 42 of the bidding document, at the time the Contract is awarded, the Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity of Goods and Related Services originally specified in Section VII, Schedule of Requirements, provided this does not exceed twenty-five (25%) percentages as specified in the Bid Data Sheet, and without any change in the unit prices or other terms and conditions of the Bid and the bidding document. So, the purchaser has decreased the quantity by 25% (i.e. 2 patrol boats) and the quantity will be 6 (six) patrol boats. The Contract Amount for the six patrol boats will be USD 1821798.00 (One Million Eight Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars).

It is mentioned in the Clause 25 of Technical Specifications of the bidding document that the Supplier will submit prior to construction, the drawings and specifications to the Purchaser and Mercantile Marine Department for scrutiny and acceptance. As Marine Mercantile Department (MMD) of Bangladesh is not the authority for approving the drawings and designs of boats and verification and certification of the drawings and designs of the boat are crucial as a pre-condition of ship construction, so you are requested to submit the verification and certification of the drawings and designs of the boat from the Department of Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) or Military Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), Dhaka or from any other international classification society prior to construction of the boats.

You are requested to furnish the Performance Security within 28 days in accordance with the Conditions of Contract, using for that purpose in the Form of Bank Guarantee.
